FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

The Event shall be known as the 2019 Endurance Racing Championship. To be held Saturday 16 November 2019 at Hampton Downs Motorsport Park, Te Kauwhata using the International Circuit configuration – Circuit 2.

There will be a practice day held at the same venue on Friday 15 November 2019.

2. JURISDICTION

This Event will be a National Race Meeting, promoted by SpeedWorks Events and the North Island Endurance Racing Drivers Club.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the 2019 Endurance Racing Championship Articles, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Four, Schedule Z being the Standing Regulations for all Race Meetings and Appendix Two, Schedule A & AA – Driver and Vehicle Safety.

4. COMPETITORS BRIEFING

A new competitors drivers' briefing will be held at 8.00am, Saturday 16th November, location is the Podium Lounge Suite, next to Race Control. A drivers' briefing will be held at 8.10am in the same location.

5. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 5.1. Competitors or their representative are reminded to bring to Documentation their Competition Licence, Competition Vehicle Log Book and a current MSNZ-affiliated Club Membership Card.
- 5.2. For Competition Cars that are subject to Audit Scrutineering this will generally take place in the competitor garages. Documentation will take place in the Event Secretariat Room next to the Technical Bay.
- 5.3. Documentation and scrutineering will be held at the following times:

Friday 15 November 2019:	8.00am to 10.00am 4.00pm to 5.00pm
Saturday 16 November 2019:	7.30am to 8.00am

6. PIT LANE

- 6.1. All persons in Pit Lane at any time while the circuit is being used for competition must have the appropriate accreditation. They must be dressed according to MSNZ regulations for the area, and for their duties at all times when they are in Pit Lane.
- 6.2. No equipment may be placed on the Signalling Wall at any time.
- 6.3. Competitors must not paint lines or markings on any part of the Pit Lane.
- 6.4. The speed limit in Pit Lane is 40kph for all vehicles.
- 6.5. At Pit Lane Entry and Pit Lane Exit, there are solid lines separating the exit and entry lanes from the circuit, known as the Blend Lines. No vehicle may cross a blend line when entering or leaving the Pit Lane. Should a vehicle cross the blend line, penalties will apply, ranging from a warning to drive through penalties.

7. IMPORTANT EVENT SPECIFIC INFORMATION

- 7.1. Pack in – this is available as follows (including those hiring garages):
Thursday 6 June – 4.00pm - 6.00pm
Friday 7 June – 7.00am – 6.00pm
Saturday 8 June – 7.00am - 8.30am
- 7.2. Trailer Parking: All open Trailers **MUST** be parked in the dedicated Trailer Park.
- 7.3. Pit Paddock Parking: The Pit Paddock area is for Competition Cars and one service vehicle per entry only, which must be in place by 8.30am on Saturday 8 June. The Pit Paddock Area will be closed to all Vehicles after this time until the completion of the event. There is a dedicated Event Parking Area in close walking distance to the Paddock Area.
- 7.4. Competitors are reminded that Event Officials and Security Staff will be present at all access gates during the Event, any Competitor or Team member who threatens or abuses, or refuses to follow instructions from a Gate Official may be penalised under National Sporting Code VIII Article 94.
- 7.5. FRIDAY PRACTICE: Competitors participating in the Friday Practice Sessions **must** sign an indemnity form at the Secretariat and will receive a wristband which must be worn by the driver during all sessions.
- 7.6. Competitor numbers: physical number banners will not be issued, you will need to ensure you have your permanent racing number displayed on your car prior to the meeting. In the case of number double-ups the organisers will be in touch with affected competitors to arrange an alternative number.
